Dec 24, · In decision making, the main normative standard is the maximization of (expected) utility, and the time required for calculation usually reduces utility. If normative models require elaborate calculation, then, when a real person attempts to apply one to a decision, the utility loss from the time spent may be greater than the gain from using.
